

## Details of Activities of NSS Unit, Nowgong College (Autonomous) for the session 2022-2023

### 1. Plantation:

On June 5th, 2022, the NSS Unit of Nowgong College, organized a successful Plantation Drive to celebrate World Environment Day. The initiative aimed to enhance environmental awareness and promote sustainable practices among students and the local community. Participants planted and distributed 200 saplings. **Mission VRKSH** (Plantation of Medicinal & Fruit Bearing Plant) is an ambitious initiative spans from 2021 to 2026, to plant 5,000 medicinal and fruit-bearing plants in their adopted villages. 1000 plant samplings were distributed and planted by the volunteers under this drive. These plants play a crucial role in supporting local biodiversity and ecosystem services by providing food and habitat for wildlife, thus maintaining ecological balance and contributing to a healthier environment.

From July 17 to August 15, 2022, Nowgong College (Autonomous) spearheaded a transformative initiative under the banner of the Chief Minister's Institutional Plantation Programme. In collaboration with National Service Scheme (NSS) unit, the college embarked on a vigorous plantation drive aimed at enhancing the campus's greenery and promoting environmental consciousness among its community. Throughout this period, students, faculty, and staff united to plant and distribute 200 saplings, each contributing to a lush and thriving green landscape.



## 2. Blood Donation Camp:

Two blood donation camps were organized in the session 2022-2023. The first camp was organized on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and the second was on 25<sup>th</sup> September. This humanitarian initiative aimed to address the critical need for blood in local hospitals and healthcare centers. Volunteers, including students and faculty, participated enthusiastically, donating blood to save lives and support the community's health infrastructure. The event underscored the NSS Unit's dedication to social responsibility and the spirit of altruism fostered within the college. A total of 95 units blood were collected, out of which the “**TeamLife**” has donated 6 units of blood and from the camps 89 units of blood were collected.



## 3. Health/Eye/Immunization Camps:

04 nos. of health checkup camps were organized during the session. On February 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the NSS Unit of Nowgong College, organized Mega Free Health Camps. This significant community outreach initiative provided essential medical services to hundreds of local residents, offering free check-ups, consultations, and basic treatments. The camp brought together a team of dedicated healthcare professionals and enthusiastic volunteers, emphasizing the college's commitment to improving public health and wellbeing. The successful event highlighted the NSS Unit's proactive role in addressing healthcare needs and fostering community welfare.





#### 4. Awareness programme/ Rallies/ Campaigns organized:

##### a) AIDS Awareness

All together 4 number of programmes were organized by the NSS Unit of Nowgong College for HIV-AIDS Awareness Camp throughout the session 2022-23. The initiative aimed to educate students and the community about HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment, and stigma reduction. Through informative sessions, discussions, and interactive activities, participants gained valuable insights into the importance of safe practices and support for those affected by the disease.

##### b) Environment Awareness

The NSS Unit of Nowgong College, organized 5 environmental awareness in the session 2022 – 23 including "Say No to Crackers" Awareness Programme. This initiative aimed to promote environmental conservation and public health by raising awareness about the harmful effects of firecrackers. Through informative sessions and campaigns, the programme educated students and the community about the importance of celebrating festivals in eco-friendly ways.

##### c) Other Awareness Programme



On the occasion of International Women's Day, the District Hub for Empowerment of Women, Nagaon, under the Department of Women and Child Development, Nagaon, organized a profound workshop titled "Youth for Equality: Understanding Gender-Positive Masculinity and Addressing Gender-Based Violence." Held in collaboration with the NSS Unit of Nowgong College (Autonomous) and supported by the Nagaon District Administration, this workshop brought together a vibrant mix of participants, including the NSS units of ADP College and Khagarijan College.



On December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the NSS Unit of Nowgong College, an Awareness Programme on Renewable Energy. This initiative aimed to educate students and the community about the importance and benefits of renewable energy sources such as rooftop solar energy. This initiative aimed to educate students and the community about the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, emphasizing the legal provisions and rights of children. Through workshops,

seminars, and discussions, participants gained understanding on identifying and reporting instances of child sexual abuse, as well as the importance of child protection measures. The programme underscored the NSS Unit's commitment to raising awareness about safeguarding children and ensuring their safety and well-being.




## 8. Gender Sensitization:

## 10. Programmes related to Plastic free:

06 nos of programmes related to plastic free were organized during the session.
