Nowgong College (Autonomous) is located in the centre of Nagaon town. This institution has a rich legacy, as it was established during the colonial period in India and later came to be associated with many renowned personalities of the state. At present the college possesses a group of extremely dedicated, experienced and professionally outstanding faculty members. Moreover, the college has a wifi enabled campus and sophisticated class rooms with modern teaching-learning aids. The college offers ICT facilities to the students to make them technologically well-versed. It has digital class rooms and a digital library. The central library of the college owns about 50,000 books, a significant number of journals and periodicals. ## THE CAMPUS

## Libraries

Nowgong College (Autonomous) offers you an incomparable library facility, both in its conventional and sophisticated modes:

The college library contains both text books and reference materials. There are about 50,000 books, a significant number of rare books, journals and periodicals in the library.

The departmental libraries help the students with books, journals and periodicals which are more subject-specific. The departments with post-graduate course receive an extra fund every year for purchasing important text books and reference books.

The digital library of the college has opened up a wider vista of knowledge and information for the students through online journals and other web-materials.

## Book Bank

## Laboratories

Botany, Chemistry, Education, Geography, Physics, Statistics and Zoology departments have laboratories for students of UG & PG programmes with necessary basic facilities. ## Postgraduate Courses

Nowgong College (Autonomous) offers postgraduate programmes (PG) under CBCS in Assamese, Botany, Chemistry, Education, English, Geography, History, Philosophy & Zoology. The Course structures of PG programme are highly subject specific. However, following nomenclature is followed in all disciplines.

**Core Courses :** These are compulsory subject-specific courses in all semesters for all students. Core course may also take the form of a dissertation/ project work / practical training comprising of laboratory work, fieldwork, seminars etc.

**Elective Courses :** These are a pool of courses within the discipline offered ideally in the second & third semesters/ third & fourth semesters, for students of the same department/institute/centre to acquire specialized or advanced knowledge or skills in an area that support the main discipline.

**Open Courses :** These are subject-specific courses offered by a department to students of other disciplines, ideally in the third & fourth semesters, to give them exposure to a subject, or to develop their proficiency/ skill in that particular discipline.

**Value Added Courses :** These are optional graded courses offered by the Arts departments. A student may choose any Value Added courses from his/her discipline or another discipline.

## Add-on courses

Add-on courses are introduced in Nowgong College (Autonomous) with an aim to expand learning platforms for the students so that they learn additional subject(s) apart from their main courses. Following interdisciplinary add-on courses are offered by different departments of the college.

## Dual Degree Programme



### Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU)

Nowgong College (Autonomous) has a regular study centre under Indira Gandhi National Open University (Nowgong College Study Centre 04171). The centre offers postgraduate & undergraduate degree programmes, diploma & certificate courses of various disciplines. A unique course called Bachelor of Preparatory Programme (BPP) is also offered under the centre in which any student without formal education such as HSLC, HS etc. may undertake this programme and after successful completion of the same, can take up undergraduate course in IGNOU. A student can study a programme of IGNOU along with his/her regular courses and can earn a dual degree. Offered courses are :-

**Postgraduate Programmes:** English (MEG), Hindi (MHD), Public Administration (MPA), History (MAH), and Sociology (MSO). Political Science (MPS), Social Work (MSW), Economics (MEC) and Commerce (M.COM)

**Undergraduate Programmes:** Tourism Studies (BTS), Bachelor of Arts & Commerce (BN8.COM), Social Work (BSW).
